What is the project number?	N-100029-0001-4
What is the project duration	540 Days; Work will begin Monday, June 22, 2020 and the completion date is projected for Tuesday, December 14, 2021.
How much footage on average will be lost due to the median?	The median width will vary, but in most cases, no more than 2 to 3 feet were lost to the new improvements
What cross street is the dividing line for the northbound projects	Briar Forest
Can you show the cut-thrus on a map instead of an aerial photo?	Plan Sets will be posted online at: <a href="http://www.publicworks.houston.tx.gov/engage">www.publicworks.houston.tx.gov/engage</a> Click on Kirkwood Paving and Drainage
Does the scope of work include excavating beneath the pavement and re-installing a strong sub-base?	Yes, the new improvements include 13 inch of concrete on 8 inches of lime stabilized base
Have the traffic control plans(TCP) been revised to coordinate with the phasing plans?	The work phases were intended to show work progress by time; the TCP plans will be implemented in phases that will include both plan sheets shown in plans and supplemental TCP within the specific work phases.
I am also concerned about the cut through. It is the main exit from our neighborhood. Any chance that that change can be readdressed. We use it daily!	All intersecting street will have a left turn lane and a median opening as part of the design.
Kirkwood has several areas of subsidence/elevation change, Will the project fill in some of these dips similar to the Hayes rd racetrack?	That should be taken care off once this project is built
Will the new road surface take into account road noise, already a big problem for those close to Kirkwood?	The new roadway/pavement will have a more smooth riding surface which will have significant reduction to existing noise.
Will there be a cut troughs at Pebble Rock, Lakeside Place and Highgrove?	Yes, all will have a median opening and left turn lane
Will there be a cut-thru on Kirkwood at Carriage Hill? Many people take that now. An earlier design looked like it did not show it.	Yes, there is a median opening and a left turn lane
Are any trees going to be removed in the process?	Yes, approximatly 80
Earlier designs had the sidewalk and bike path combined- is that still the plan?	Yes, one side (west) will have a sidewalk, the other side (east) will have the shared path
Are bike lanes on east or west side of Kirkwood?	Bike lane/shared path is on the east side (northbound)
How about bike routes? Are they going to be part of the right lanes or isolated from the traffic?	There is a 10 foot shared Path, which includes Biking. The shared Path is isolated from traffic lanes is located behind the curb on the east side of Kirkwood.

Is the shared bike lane elevated?	Bike lanes are isolated from Traffic
Will the sidewalk just cut off after the bridge or will it continue to the nearest intersection; If the sidewalk cuts off on the new construction will people still be able to walk on either side	The Bridge is not part of this project and Yes they can walk on both side
Will bike lanes be painted green like in midtown?	No
So the bike lane/pedestrian walkway will be on one side and 10 feet wide. At the bridge over the bayou, how is that going to work since the walkway is narrow there?	The bridge is not part of the scope for this project.
The last I was told was that the esplanades will be reduced by about 5 ft on each side to allow for wider sidewalks/bike lanes (excellent change). How will this change interact with the existing bridge over Buffalo Bayou (will the lanes jog over to meet the existing lanes and it seems there won't be a bike lane over the bridges??	The bridge is not part of the scope for this project.
What previous experience does R construction have?	R Construction is a 40 year old company; we have been engaged in utility and roadway construction since 1999. Our team has completed over \$1BB of work, including COH projects, Harris County, TxDOT, and many other municipalities. We are based here in 77042.
Is this the same contractor who worked on Memorial?	No, the contractor for this project is R Construction Contractors.
Where will the contractor locate his office, staging area?	RCC yard is planned to be at Centerpoint easement on Briar Forest (near south end of Westside Tennis)
When will the City construction signs be erected.	City signs will be installed the week of June 22nd.
When will the contractor place door hangers on the residents doors?	The door hangers will be posted on the week of June 22nd, prior to the commencement of work.
Will construction be taking place during the day or at night?	The contractor will work Monday-Saturday from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. There will be no work on Sundays or on City of Houston Holidays.

The Kirkwood section is in worst shape halfway from Briar Forest to Westheimer. How come that section is not included in the plan?	That section is part of the second phase
Why isn't this project going to Westheimer?	The project is divided into two Phases/segments. This is the first Phase. The second phase is Kirkwood from Briar Forest to Westheimer, which is currently in the design phase.
